You will learn to start colts from the ground as well as being exposed to starting colts with a dependable saddle horse. You will learn what things can be done in the first few rides to stimulate a young horse's mind and help it find its way through what's it's being asked.

Come learn the colt starting approach that earned Mule the Arkansas state colt starting championship and second place at the national championship in Virginia in 2008. You and your colt will both be glad you did!

This 3 day clinic will focus on building a foundation of self-confidence for the horse, key to the horse realizing its' full potential. In addition to flexion, yielding and impulsion, the clinic will cover the following elements of the training process:

- When to apply pressure, when to apply patience
- Teaching the young horse to 'seek the release'
- Creating a balance between confidence and 'freedom to resist'
- 2 Stages of Control; Emotional and Physical
