Develop skills necessary to effectively work stock through clear communication with your horse and proper positioning on the cattle. Riders must be confident and effective at walk/trot, must be at least 14 yrs of age. Limited to 10 horses/riders.

The Side Pass

Two man gate exercise
Two man Trailer Loading
Two man, multiple cow,
Trailer Loading
