

RANCH ROPING CLINIC

LEARN THE ART OF QUIET, LOW STRESS CATTLE HANDLING

Learn to use a rope in practical working ranch situations. Heading, heeling, and groundwork are covered. This is not Team Roping. Smooth efficiency and safety are stressed. From building a loop to tying down cattle, whether you are just beginning to rope, or if you catch cattle outside regularly, there will be something for you. Shots covered include over 8 different head shots and 15 heel shots. Learn techniques to work in a three man crew, a two man crew, or by yourself.

This clinic will be conducted by Mule Thornbrugh and Iain Davis. **Mule Thornbrugh** is a professional horseman and clinician operating out of the Double Diamond T Ranch in Winslow, AR. **Iain Davis** is a working ranch cowboy, founder of the Northeast Oklahoma Ranch Roping Association, and cattle handling clinician.
